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SOUTHWEST ISLANDS FIELD-TRIF

The southwest islands includes the states of Sonsorol and Hatchobei at the very end of Palac's waters toward the south. Sonsorol State includes Pulu-Anna, Merin, and Fanna islands while Hatchobei State is comprised of the

sites known as Helen's Reef and Piersu-

Sonsorol State is approximately 80-240 Miles from Koror with a rich fishing grounds surrounding the islands. Naturiobei is about 382 miles from Koror with village structures much the same as in the old days despite somewhat madern houses alongside. The extensive but untauched ntoll life makes the islands a natural sanctuary for many species of tertiles and various birds.

From Koror to Sonsors! takes over 23 hours and to Patobobei from Sonsorol is approximately 15 hours by ship. The people of the island still live a simple life and while state governments provide them supplies and news from

time to time, they enjoy and ublizes what Nature have provided them over the years. A scientific expedition of the Green Peace Organization in 1932 proclaimed the island of Helen's Reef of Hatchlobel State as one of the greatest diving spots in Palau.

This is a one-week field-trip to the southwest departing Koror on February 23rd and return by March 2rd. We will visit all the islands as well as Helen's Reef and everyone will have a chance to feel the sands and taste the coconut drinks. All passengers must abide by any rules concerning the islands from the Ship Captain and/or the tour guide

such as not taking turtle or bird eggs or throwing garbage at sea or on land ots...

The whole package over cost for the one-week field trip is \$560.00 per person, which includes three meals a day for the whole week plus a "personal accident plan" insurance of up to \$100.000.00 while you enjoy the riches of the southwest islanders.

Seats are sold on a "first come, first serve" basis and refunds can be requested up until February 15th. After that, there will be no refunds but replacement is acceptable. For seet purchase please call 488-1461/1641.



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
